1:00 p.m.	<p>Depart Hotel for Carcross (60 minutes)</p> <p><i>Carcross, originally known as Caribou Crossing, was fishing and hunting camp for Inland Tlingit and Tagish people. 4,500-year-old artifacts from First Nations People living in the area have been found in the region. Caribou Crossing was named after the migration of huge numbers of caribou across the natural land bridge between Lake Bennett and Nares Lake. The modern village began in 1896, during the Klondike Gold Rush. At the time, Caribou Crossing was a popular stopping place for prospectors going to and from the gold fields of Dawson City.</i></p> <p><i>Carcross relies on tourism to support the local economy. It lies on the Klondike Highway between Whitehorse and Skagway, Alaska and offers a variety of historic attractions and outdoor activities. Just north of the town is the Carcross Desert, often referred to as the "world's smallest desert."</i></p> <p>During the drive back from Carcross, participants will experience firsthand the outstanding scenery of the Yukon and make brief photo stops at Carcross Commons, Emerald Lake and Carcross Desert.</p>
