The RCGS was built to showcase Canada's accomplishments on the world stage. It's only fitting that a hub for exploration and geographic education in Canada should be situated at the confluence of two historic rivers. The Rideau Falls mark where the eponymous river joins the Ottawa River, which forms the border between Canada's two largest provinces — a symbolic connection between English- and French-speaking Canadians. Prior to confederation, the Ottawa River and its tributaries supported indigenous peoples and served as important trade routes, and were later



explored by famed adventurers including Cartier, Brûlé and Champlain. Champlain described the Rideau Falls in his 1613 expedition, which resulted in some of the very first maps of Canada.
